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Controlling Body	Pivotal Gymnastics Management

In addition to Gymnastics Australia's Code of Behaviour, you must meet the following requirements regarding your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by Gymnastics Australia, a member association or an affiliated club and in your role as Official or Judge:

1. Understand and abide by the Judge's Oath.
2. Be fully conversant with the International Gymnastics Federation Code of Points and/or any other published rules and regulations pertaining to the standard of gymnastics being judged.
3. Actively maintain technical knowledge through ongoing review of the Code of Points, technical publications, videos and gym floor participation.
4. Keep up to date with the latest trends in officiating and the principles of growth and development of young people.
5. Be consistent, objective and courteous when making decisions.
6. Condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all opponents.
7. Emphasise the spirit of gymnastics.
8. Be a good sport yourself. Actions speak louder than words, your behaviour and comments should be positive and supportive.
9. Dress in a tidy fashion befitting the status and image of a judge.
10. Attend all pre-competition judges' meetings
11. Be punctual for all official events.
12. Place the safety and welfare of the participants above all else.
13. Give all young people a 'fair go' regardless of their club, gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
14. Be prepared for the competition by having all personal judging equipment and accessories readily available and by being conversant with the apparatus and exercises
15. Be cooperative with competition organisers, floor managers, announcers and head judges
16. Be quick and accurate in determining scores
